



COVID-19 Policy and Procedure for Quarantine Upon Admission	
Determining Quarantine Period with Vaccination and Exposure Information	<p>It is the Policy of Haven Health that the facility protect the health and well-being of our residents and staff during infectious disease outbreaks. In order to do this the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) recommends the quarantine of residents who have been potentially exposed to a contagious disease and monitor for signs and symptoms for a determined amount of time.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Prior to admission the facility will obtain information regarding the vaccination and exposure status of each resident. Once this information is obtained the facility will determine appropriate quarantine periods based upon the information received. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A fully vaccinated individual who has not had any exposure to someone with COVID-19, including residing in a facility with a COVID-19 outbreak, within the last 14 days will not require a quarantine period. • Previously infected persons (that are not fully vaccinated) with an exposure to someone with COVID-19 do not need to quarantine if they meet ALL of the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exposure is within 3 months of symptom onset of their initial illness or since specimen collection (if asymptomatic) of the first positive COVID-19 PCR/antigen test; AND • Have met criteria to end isolation; AND • Remain asymptomatic. <p>However, if a previously infected person (that is not fully vaccinated) is identified as a contact of a case 3 months or more after symptom onset or since specimen collection (if asymptomatic) of the first positive COVID-19 PCR/antigen test, they should follow quarantine recommendations for contacts.</p>
Unvaccinated Residents	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. A resident who has not been vaccinated or previously infected will still be required to complete the 14-day quarantine period.
Vaccinated and Previously Infected Residents	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3. Residents who are fully vaccinated or have previously been infected and meet the criteria as listed above may be cohorted with other residents as deemed appropriate by the IDT.
Room Placement	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 4. If quarantine is required a private room will be utilized for that resident if one is available. In the event that a private room is not available a semiprivate room will be used and residents will be cohorted based on like illnesses. Refer to COVID-19 Infection Control Policy and Procedure for guidance.
Symptomatic Residents	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5. A resident who becomes symptomatic despite their vaccination status will need to be isolated and the appropriate testing and treatment completed.
